DIRECTIONS & PARKING INFO Bayfront Lodge and Cabin

Coming from Pensacola (on US-98) ... from the West end of the Pensacola Bay 3 Mile Bridge, drive East about 16 miles until you reach E Bay Blvd (FL SR-399). Turn Left and follow E Bay Blvd about 1.9 miles until you reach **Bayfront Lodge and Cabin** on your left.

Coming from Destin (on US-98) ... from the East end of the Destin William T. Marler bridge, drive West about 28 miles until you reach Bergren Road. Turn right and head North on Bergren Rd about 1.1 miles until you reach E Bay Blvd (FL SR-399). Turn left onto E Bay Blvd about 0.2 miles until you reach **Bayfront Lodge and Cabin** on your right miles.

Coming from Milton (on US-90 / Caroline Street) ... from downtown Milton, drive West about 2.8 miles to Avalon Blvd (TOLL road FL SR-281). Turn Left onto Avalon Blvd and continue South about 16 miles to Gulf Breeze Pkwy (US-98). Turn left and continue East about 4 miles until you reach E Bay Blvd (FL SR-399). Turn Left and follow East Bay Blvd about 1.9 miles until you reach **Bayfront Lodge and Cabin** on your left.

Bayfront Lodge and Cabin Parking: Vehicles are to be parked in designated parking areas only, which include any part of the paved or the graveled areas. Parking on the road, sidewalk, grass, or any area that is not otherwise paved or graveled is not permitted.

*** IMPORTANT *** Overflow parking is available on the WEST side of Zilla Street (See FIGURE 1 below)


BOAT RAMP INFO

Bayfront Lodge and Cabin, LLC — Bayfront Lodge offers a private boat ramp that makes bringing your own small watercraft on vacation especially easy. The boat ramp is 9' wide but can only be accessed by backing through the garage. The front garage door is 15.8' Wide & 88.5" High. **The back garage door is 117" Wide & 91" High.**

Bal Alex Boat Ramp — 8 minutes by car from Bayfront. 7am - 10pm (Gulf Breeze Parks & Rec.)
4180 Sandy Bluff Drive, Gulf Breeze, FL 32563

This ramp sits on 4.6 acres along the southern shores East Bay and offers: Single launching lane, courtesy dock, picnic table and parking for 6-8 boat trailers. Hand launch Kayaks easily at this location. Shoreline fishing along the parks bulkhead.

Dickerson City Boat Ramp — 20 minutes by car from Bayfront (TOLL on FL SR-281 bridge). Boat ramp is open 24 Hours. (SRC Parks & Rec.)

1200 Vista Del Mar Drive, Milton, FL 32583

Located on the East side of the Garcon Point peninsula. OK to hand launch Kayaks but very shallow and **NO Parking or Facilities** at this Ramp

East River Boat Ramp — 13 minutes by car from Bayfront. 7am - 10pm (SRC Parks & Rec.)

2939 FL SR-87 and East River Boat Ramp Road, Navarre, FL 32566

The East River boat ramp in Gulf Breeze offers: Single launching lane, courtesy dock, parking for about 10 boat trailers and portable toilets.

Garcon Point Boat Ramp — 18 minutes by car from Bayfront (TOLL @ FL SR-281 bridge). 7am - 10pm. Ramp is open 24 hours. (SRC Parks & Rec.)

200 South Garcon Point Road, Milton, FL 32583

Located on the Northwest end of the Garcon Point Bridge. Garcon Point boat ramp in Milton near where the East Bay meets Escambia Bay offers: Single launching lane and courtesy dock. Parking for boat trailers is limited to about 5. No restrooms at this location. Watch ramp drop-off at this location.

Holley Public Boat Ramp #1 — 18 minutes by car from Bayfront. Open 24hrs (SRC Parks & Rec.).

3100 Live Oak Street, Navarre, FL 32566

The Holley Public boat ramp offers: Single launching lane and courtesy dock. Unfortunately, no parking at this location.

Navarre Beach / Sound Side Park Boat Ramp — 15 minutes by car from Bayfront (SRC Parks & Rec.).

1451 Navarre Beach Causeway and Florida National Scenic Trail (FL SR-399), Navarre, FL 32566

Public Boat Ramps/Launches (continued):

Oriole Beach Boat Ramp — 14 minutes by car from Bayfront. 7am - 10pm. Boat ramp is open 24 hours (SRC Parks & Rec.)

3165 Linden Avenue, Gulf Breeze, FL 32563

The Oriole Beach boat ramp offers: 2 launching lanes, courtesy dock, 25 boat trailer parking spaces, picnic tables and port-o-lets. A fishing pier on site also.

Quietwater Beach Boat Ramp — 24 minutes by car from Bayfront (TOLL on FL SR-399 bridge). Ramp is open 24 hours. (Escambia County Parks & Rec.)

Located at the Southeast end of the Pensacola Beach TOLL Bridge (FL SR-399).

Shoreline Park Boat Ramp — 20 minutes by car from Bayfront. Closest to Pensacola Beach. (Gulf Breeze Parks & Rec.)

Closest intersection is: South Sunset Boulevard and Shoreline Drive, Gulf Breeze, FL 32561

From the above intersection go 650' on Shoreline Drive. Entrance to the park will be on the right.

The Shoreline Park boat ramp along Santa Rosa Sound offers: 2 launching lanes, courtesy docks, pavilions, 43 paved boat trailer parking spaces and restrooms. A fishing pier on site also.

Wayside Park (Gulf Breeze) Boat Ramp (CONSTRUCTION: Open: Summer 2024) — 20 minutes by car from Bayfront. (Gulf Breeze Parks & Rec.)

Located at the Southern end of the Pensacola Bay "3 Mile"/"General Daniel 'Chappie' James, Jr." Bridge on US-98.

Woodlawn Beach Boat Ramp — 6 minutes by car from Bayfront. 7am - 10pm. Boat ramp is open 24 hours (SRC Parks & Rec.)

1422 Woodlawn Beach Road (SRC 191D), Gulf Breeze, FL 32563

The Woodlawn Beach boat ramp in Gulf Breeze offers: Single launching lane, courtesy dock and about 40 boat trailer parking spaces and portable restrooms. The launching or recovery of boats over 18 feet in length at this ramp can be difficult at low tides.
